SUPPORT FROM A ROCHA

A Rocha did their annual clean up of the Sandbach Environmental trail recently, ensuring it is as rubbish-free as possible before spring arrives. The Sandbach Environmental Trail explores the natural history of Sandbach and our human impact on it.



The trail is 2 miles long and takes 45-90 minutes to walk. The circular route starts from the Crosses in Market Square, goes via the Post Office, Brook Bridge, the Town Pump, the Library, Sandbach Park Pond, Betchton Close amenity area, upper

Sandbach Park and the Town Hall, then returns to the Crosses.
