Emma, a member of Haslington Guide Group, contacted the Clean Team to organise a litter pick with the Guides as part of one of her award badges.

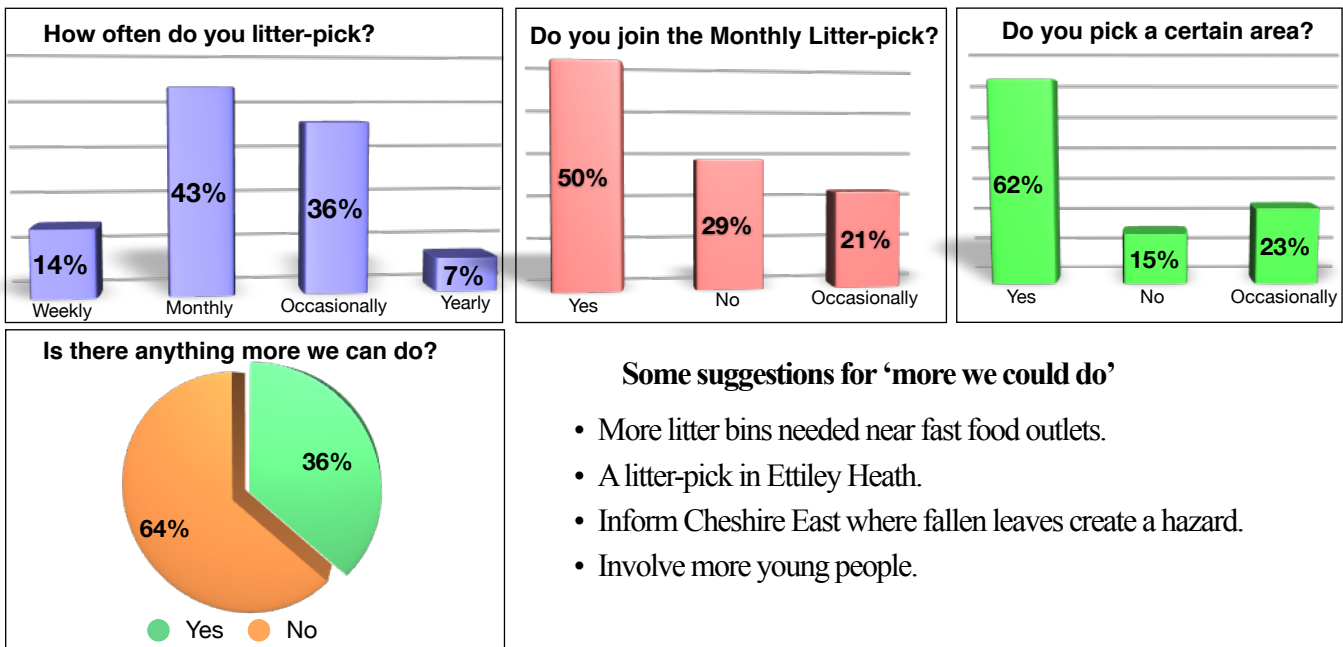
The outcome was a well-supported and highly enthusiastic meeting one evening in October, and there are plans for a litter pick in Haslington Village in the spring of 2013.
